A list of what is included in the cost and a general itinerary has been attached. We are in need of 4 male chaperones and 4 female chaperones one of which needs to have current First Aid training. There will be 1 teacher and 1 administrator (Mrs. Romphf's Replacement and Mrs. Ives) on the trip. Please keep in mind that the costs can be lowered with fundraising. A more accurate and detailed itinerary will be distributed closer to the travel date.

A student must be achieving a grade of at least a "B" on the 2nd term reporting period in his/her ensemble and must be able to play all the music performed on the music tour. Students must be doing well in his/her other classes to participate in this trip, upon the discretion of the other teachers and the administration. **Students are also not "excused" from homework missed and will need to make up the work in his/her own time.** Keep in mind that this music trip is a privilege and only students who are trustworthy and deserving will be able to participate.

Also, *students need to have their own passport* and, if applicable, necessary papers to travel across the U.S./ Canadian Border.

Because the cost of this trip is fairly high, I have broken down the cost into 3 instalments.

Please make cheques payable to CHMPA:

- 1st payment of \$100.00 per person due on or before December 12th, 2014 to begin booking process (only \$50 is refundable).
- 2nd payment of \$200.00 per person due January 31st, 2015 (refundable only before March 1st, 2015).
- Final payment due March 1st, 2015 (after this date only \$50 of the overall cost is refundable). A package will be sent home with forms to fill out as well as the amount that is due.

Proposal for Grade 8 Concert Band Trip

SEATTLE: Wednesday, May 13th to Saturday, May 16th 2015

ESTIMATED TOUR COST: \$575Cdn per person

(Based on 70 students and 10 chaperones)

COST INCLUDES:

- motorcoach transportation for 4 days including driver accommodation and ferry
- return ferry fees for all passengers from Swartz Bay to Tsawwassen
- 3 nights hotel accommodation based on quads for the students and twins for the chaperones
- 3 breakfasts, 3 lunches and 4 dinners
- workshop with a university clinician for 1 ½ hours
- arrangement of 3 performances at local schools or venues
- entrance to Experience Music Project
- admission to the Seattle Mariners baseball game
- admission to the "Ride the Duck" Tour of Seattle
- RBC Youth Student Package Insurance Insurance (includes emergency medical coverage, cancellation and interruption.)
- Chaperone costs (except food)

NOT INCLUDED:

- breakfast and lunch on Wednesday (a pack lunch or money will be needed for this day)
- items of a personal nature
- passport photos and government processing fees
- Visa fee if required

Wednesday 13	VICTORIA/VANCOUVER/SEATTLE Your private charter bus will pick you up at school. Ferry from Swartz Bay to Tsawwassen for tour members, bus and driver. Drive from Tsawwassen to Seattle by private charter bus. Performance at a local elementary school en-route. Transfer to your hotel for check-in. Evening pizza dinner at your hotel. Accom: Moderate hotel located near the Seattle Center (3 nights)
Thursday 14	SEATTLE Hot and cold breakfast buffet at your hotel. Morning workshop with a local clinician – 1 concert band clinic. Time at Pike Place Market to purchase lunch. Entrance to the Experience Music Project and Science Fiction Museums. Dinner at the Hard Rock Cafe. Tickets to the Seattle Mariners vs the Red Sox. Transfer back to your hotel by school bus.
Friday 15	SEATTLE Hot and cold breakfast buffet at your hotel. Morning performance at local elementary school. Transfer to a local Mall where there will be time to purchase lunch. Early afternoon performance at a local elementary school. Afternoon Ride the Ducks Tour. Transfer downtown for some shopping time and to purchase dinner. Walk back to your hotel after shopping (or you may wish to catch the Monorail).
Saturday 16	SEATTLE/VANCOUVER/VICTORIA Hot and cold breakfast buffet at your hotel. Drive from Seattle to Tulalip where a stop will be made at the outlet malls to purchase lunch and for some shopping. Continue to Tsawwassen. Ferry from Tsawwassen to Swartz Bay for tour members, bus and driver. Transfer back to school.
